

418 runners set for NorCal

More than 400 runners have signed up for Sunday's 15th annual Bud Lite NorCal '85 foot races at Lake Redding Park.

By late Thursday, 418 runners had signed up. Entries will be taken until 9:30 a.m. Sunday. Runners can register at the Red Lion Motor Inn in Redding Saturday from noon to 6 p.m. All runners who have pre-registered for Redding's oldest running event can pick up their racing packets during those hours.

The three- and 10-mile races start at 10 a.m. Sunday on Diestlehorst Bridge. A one-mile fun run will start at 9:30.

The entry fee for the three- or 10-mile runs is \$8. The cost to Shasta Wonderland Elite Athletic Team (SWEAT) members, the sponsoring organization, is \$7.

Of the runners entered, there

are 125 men registered for the three-miler and 115 women. In the 10-mile run there are 90 men and 17 women.

Course records for the three-miler are: Don Merwin of Hayfork, 14 minutes, 40 seconds in 1983. Denae Dunlap, a senior at Anderson High School set the standard of 18:25 for women in 1983.

For the 10-mile run, Eileen Claugus of Sacramento established the time to beat in 1983 when she was clocked in 64:24. Larry Lawson of Reno owns the mark to beat for the men, 49:29, also set in 1983.
