# Hundreds take part in river run

Nearly 500 runners competed in the 41st Nor-Cal John Frank Memorial Run on Saturday along the Sacramento River Trail.

Mario Mendoza, 25, of Bend took first place in the 10-mile run with a time of 51:53, followed by 23-year-old Jesse Regnier of Lafayette at 51:55 and 25-year-old Tim Tollefson of Roseville at 52:24.

The top three women were Jane Kibil, 25, of Auburn, who finished 22nd overall with a time of 57:15;

23-year-old Madeline Kramer of Berkeley who took 39th overall with 1:00:19 and 44-year-old Valerie Young of Novato with 1:01:55.

In the 3-mile race, 18-year-old Eric Ghelfi of Redding took first place with a time of 15:49 followed by 19-year-old Kenny Pennington of Redding with 16:48 and 42-year-old Tim MacLean of Redding with 17:24. The top three women were 13-year-old Mary Orders of Moraga with 18:35, 17-year-old Lora James of Redding with 18:43 and 15-year-old Hannah Dobman of Anderson with 18:48.
